

**MOSSL and Buckeye Premier Bylaws regarding Tryouts are to be interpreted as follows:**

- Any player, (currently a member of your club or one who is not a member of your club), can be invited to your tryouts beginning May 15th. They can ONLY be told about the times, dates and locations of your club's tryouts, but nothing more. They **cannot** be told that a spot is being reserved for them, that they don't have to show up, etc. This is to be broadly interpreted. Clubs / coaches may not attempt to circumvent the intent of these bylaws.
- The tryouts for next season's U-9's through U-12's teams and next season's U-17's through U-19's teams can be held starting on May 28th. Players who are currently a member of the club that is holding a tryout as shown in the preceding sentence can be offered a spot on one of the club's teams for the next year in the U-9 through U-12 and U-17 through U-19 age groups on May 28th.
- The tryouts for next year's U-13's through U-16's teams can be held starting on June 3<sup>rd</sup>. Players who are currently a member of the club that is holding a tryout as shown in the preceding sentence can be offered a spot on one of the club's teams for the next year in the U-13 through U-16 groups on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Players must be given at least 24 hours to decide to accept an offer to play for a specific team. This applies whether or not the player is currently a member of the club or not. For example, this bylaw means:
  - A U-11G player who **is** member of the club is given an offer to play for a club's U-11 "B" team at 5:00 PM on May 28<sup>th</sup>, (the first day of tryouts). The club may not require the player to accept the offer until 5:00 PM on May 29<sup>th</sup>
  - A U-10B player who **is not** a member of the club is given an offer to play for a club's U-10 "A" team at 9:00 PM on May 29<sup>th</sup>, (the second day of tryouts). The club may not require the player accept the offer until 9:00 PM on May 30<sup>th</sup>
